#### REGULAR MEETING OF FLORENCE CITY COUNCIL MONDAY, AUGUST 8, 2011 - 1:00 P.M. CITY-COUNTY COMPLEX, CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, ROOM 604 FLORENCE, SOUTH CAROLINA

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Stephen J. Wukela called the regular meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Pro tem Frank J. Brand, II; Councilman Edward Robinson; Councilman Stephen C. Powers; Councilwoman Teresa Myers Ervin; and Councilman Glynn F. Willis.

<u>MEMBERS ABSENT:</u> Councilwoman Octavia Williams-Blake was unable to attend the meeting.

ALSO PRESENT: Mr. David N. Williams, City Manager; Mrs. Dianne M. Rowan, Municipal Clerk; Mr. James W. Peterson, Jr., City Attorney; Chief Anson Shells, Florence Police Department; Mr. Scotty Davis, Director of Community Services; Mr. Drew Griffin, Director of Public Works and Utilities and Mr. Tom Shearin, Special Services Administrator.

Notices of this regular meeting were sent to the media informing them of the date, time and place of the meeting.

Mr. Tucker Mitchell of the Morning News and Ms. Tonya Brown of WPDE TV-15 were present for the meeting.

#### **INVOCATION**

Councilwoman Teresa Myers Ervin gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mayor Pro tem Brand made a motion to adopt the minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 11, 2011 and the minutes of the Special Meeting of July 22, 2011. Councilman Willis seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### SPECIAL RECOGNITIONS AND HONORS

On behalf of Councilwoman Octavia Williams-Blake, Mayor Wukela recognized the Drs. Bruce and Lee Foundation as the citizen of the month for the City of Florence. Mr. Bradley Callicott was presented a certificate in recognition of being named the Citizen of the Month for August, 2011.

Mayor Wukela presented Todd Newell, of the Fire Department, with a certificate in recognition of completing 10 years of service with the City of Florence.

Mr. Michael Morris received a certificate from Mayor Wukela in recognition of completing 10 years of service with the City of Florence.

#### **APPEARANCE BEFORE COUNCIL**

# MR. WALTER FLEMING, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE PEE DEE COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY AND REV. MACK HINES – TO ADDRESS COUNCIL CONCERNING POSSIBLE COOPERATIVE WITH CITY TO ADDRESS COMMUNITY ISSUES.

Mr. Fleming and Rev. Hines appeared before Council and requested \$30-35,000 in funding from the City to be used for the operations of the Weed and Seed Program that is located in the north Florence area.

Councilman Powers made a motion that this issue be referred to the City Council Budget Committee for review and recommendation. Mayor Pro tem Brand seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The budget committee was also instructed to review possible in-kind services.

## MR. ROBERT JONES - TO ADDRESS COUNCIL REGARDING A PROPOSAL TO NAME THE MARION STREET FIRE DEPARTMENT.

Mr. Jones spoke to Council regarding Florence Fire Station #2 located on Marion Street in North Florence. This station has never been named. Mr. Jones listed seven of the first black firefighters hired by the City and requested that the Marion Street Fire Station be named for one of these firefighters.

Councilman Robinson supported this request and asked what the procedure would be for naming the fire station.

Mayor Wukela responded that staff would be asked to investigate and propose names. Also it will be addressed if in fact the station should be named. After this is completed, staff will make a recommendation to Council as to potential names and whether or not it should be named.

Councilwoman Ervin encouraged that the names that Mr. Jones mentioned be given priority consideration.

Mr. David Williams added that a letter has been received from a former firefighter requesting that the new fire station (Fire Station #5) be named as well.

Mayor Wukela stated that Council would receive recommendations from staff and consider both of these requests at the same time.

There was no objection from Council to this procedure.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

## A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO RECEIVE INPUT ON THE 2011 EDWARD F. BYRNES GRANT FOR FY 2011-2012 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,257.

Chief Anson Shells reported that this year the Police Department is requesting \$42,257 from the Edward F. Byrnes Grant program to purchase equipment. This year the department would like to begin work on establishing a camera system in the downtown area of Florence by purchasing cameras and equipment associated with system installation, storage of video imaging, and maintenance of equipment. The department will also purchase a firearms simulation system, which is designed to enhance tactical response to live fire incidents. Over the next year the department intends to increase the active shooter training in schools to make sure they are properly prepared to handle potential school shooting situations. The equipment required under this system includes a weapons simulation, helmets, face masks, and throat protection.

Mayor Wukela opened the public hearing at 1:27 p.m. There were no questions.

Mayor Wukela declared the public hearing closed at 1:28 p.m.

#### BILL NO. 2011-17 - SECOND READING

AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE 304 KEMP STREET, TM #90118-03-003, FROM R-4, LIMITED MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL TO B-3, GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT.

An Ordinance to rezone 304 Kemp Street, TM # 90118-03-003, from R-4, Limited Multi-Family Residential to B-3, General Commercial District was adopted on second reading.

Mayor Pro tem Brand made a motion to adopt Bill No. 2011-17 on second reading. Councilman Willis seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### BILL NO. 2011-18 - FIRST READING

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-75 OF THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS OF THE CITY-COUNTY CIVIC CENTER COMMISSSION, ONE APPOINTED BY THE FLORENCE CITY COUNCIL AND ONE APPOINTED BY THE FLORENCE COUNTY COUNCIL.

An Ordinance to amend Section 2-75 of the City Code to provide for two additional members of the City-County Civic Center Commission, one appointed by the Florence City Council and one appointed by the Florence County Council was deferred.

Mayor Pro tem Brand made a motion to defer Bill No. 2011-18 until the September 12, 2011 regular City Council meeting. Councilman Willis seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### **BILL NO. 2011-19 - FIRST READING**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A PARCEL OF UNIMPROVED LAND CONTAINING 0.020 ACRE (871 SQUARE FEET), MORE OR LESS, BEING SHOWN ON A MAP PREPARED BY SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DATED JUNE 29, 2011 AND BEING THE PARCEL DESIGNATED AS TAX MAP 00146-01-083 IN THE RECORDS OF THE FLORENCE COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR.

An Ordinance authorizing the sale of a parcel of unimproved land containing 0.020 acre (871 square feet), more or less, being shown on a map prepared by South Carolina Department of Transportation dated June 29, 2011 and being the parcel designated as Tax Map 00146-02-083 in the records of the Florence County Tax Assessor was passed on first reading.

Mr. Tom Shearin, Special Services Administrator, reported to Council that this parcel was declared surplus by City Council at the City Council meeting of July 11, 2011. This parcel is approximately 1/50<sup>th</sup> of an acre located on TV Road. The South Carolina Department of Transportation is interested in purchasing this parcel to use in their road widening project. SCDOT has agreed to pay \$900.00 for this surplus property which has appraised for less than \$900.00. As required by the South Carolina Code of Laws and the Code of Ordinances for the City of Florence, property owned by the City can be sold only after approval of Council by Ordinance.

Mayor Pro tem Brand made a motion to pass Bill No. 2011-19 on first reading. Councilman Powers seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 2011-14

#### A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE SEPTEMBER 2011 AS NATIONAL RECOVERY MONTH

A Resolution to declare September 2011 as National Recovery Month was adopted by Council. Councilwoman Teresa Myers Ervin made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2011-14. Mayor Pro tem Brand seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-15**

## <u>A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE SEPTEMBER 27, 2011 AS "WILSON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1971 40<sup>TH</sup> CLASS REUNION RECOGNITION DAY".</u>

A Resolution to declare September 27, 2011 as Wilson Senior High School Class of 1971 40<sup>th</sup> Class Reunion Recognition Day was adopted by Council.

Councilman Willis made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2011-15. Councilman Powers seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-16**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CREATION OF A CONDITIONAL GRANT TO THE FLORENCE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A LOAN FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000 TO ASSIST IN CONSTURCITON FINANCING TO ENABLE EXPANSION OF FIX-A-BLOCK PROGRAM AS A METHOD OF ENCOURAGING THE REDEVELOPMENT OF BLIGHTED NEIGHBORHOODS IN THE CITY AND THE RESULTING PROVISION OF SAFE AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Ms. Jeanne Downing, a member of the Seeds for Development board, reported to Council that she is in support of the proposed Conditional Grant Agreement that is being considered by Council. The Seeds for Development board is a sub-board of the Florence Community Development Agency.

The basic concept is that the City agrees to provide a funding source for the construction of one house that will be built in a selected area. Using the Fix-A-Block concept, the focus will be on a concentrated area until that block or area has been turned around and is no longer seen as a blighted area. The funds are not released until all elements of the deal are in place; this includes a lot, a floor plan, and a buyer who has been approved for a loan on the house. Only then will the funds be released to pay the costs of site development and construction in the same manner that construction loans would be funded. Once the house is completed the buyer goes to closing and the proceeds of the sale are used to pay back the city in full. Seeds for Neighborhood Growth retain any profits and leftover proceeds which will be used to assist owners in the same area to repaint, repair or improve their homes through loans and/or grants. At the end of one complete cycle the City has a zero investment in the house. This cycle repeats itself one house at a time, one block at a time, one neighborhood at a time until the problem of blight is eliminated. Benefits to the community include: one less vacant and/or overgrown lot; one more owner paying property taxes and water bill; a neighborhood has been upgraded; stimulated local business with the purchase of building materials; provided jobs for building tradesmen; very likely reduced crime in the area due to one less unattended property; one small step taken to improving the image of the downtown area by eliminating an eyesore; and have introduced hope into a neighborhood by showing that things are

finally getting better. This program does not ask for a "hand out" but a "hand up". Ms. Downing requested that Council approve the plan.

Mayor Pro tem Brand expressed his support of the program. Mayor Pro tem Brand stated that this is a systematic approach that with good control can be done the right way. Mayor Pro tem Brand commended Councilman Robinson and City Attorney Jim Peterson for their extensive work on this concept.

Councilman Robinson stated that the Housing Authority has agreed to give the Florence Community Development Agency a lot in the 300 block of Jarrott Street, to be used for the site of the first home.

Mr. Jim Peterson, City Attorney added that he felt this concept has many safety nets in place that adds to the potential success of the program. Mr. Peterson stated that the concept of the program is that the City will make money available in a grant to support the financing, but at the closing of the home, which is pre-sold and the financing is pre-approved, the money comes back in to be available to use for the next house. There is also a component in the program where as part of this process the City would serve as a maintainer of a list of charitable organizations that are interested in helping.

Councilman Powers made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2011-16. Councilman Robinson seconded the motion.

Mayor Wukela stated that he agreed with Mayor Pro tem Brand's desire, while this is a good goal to achieve, that the City maintains stringent control over the taxpayers' dollars.

Mayor Wukela made a motion to amend that the agreement states: 1) that the licensed builder will be approved by the City of Florence; 2) payments will be made directly to the licensed builders, after all of the approvals and inspections as set forth in the agreement have been met, without going through any other entity; 3) and receipts from the financial institution be received directly by the City of Florence without going through any other entity. Mayor Pro tem Brand seconded the motion.

The motion to amend passed unanimously.

The motion as amended passed unanimously.

#### REPORTS TO COUNCIL

#### APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Councilman Robinson made a motion to defer this item and added that he would also like for the method of appointing members be reviewed. Councilman Willis seconded the motion. Mayor Wukela added that members currently serving on a board or commission will continue to serve until reappointments or new appointments are made by Council. The motion passed unanimously.

## <u>DISCUSSION OF OWNERSHIP OPTIONS RELATED TO ROYAL KNIGHT BUILDING IN</u> <u>DOWNTOWN FLORENCE – MR. RAY REICH, DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT MANAGER.</u>

Mayor Pro tem Brand made a motion to defer this item until the September meeting. Councilman Powers seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### OTHER BUSINESS REQUIRING COUNCIL ACTION

## COUNCILMAN ROBINSON – WOULD LIKE TO DISCUSS SETTING A SCHEDULE FOR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS THAT WILL BE HELD IN THE COMMUNITY.

Councilman Robinson stated that Council has taken action previously that allows for a regular council meeting to be held in the community on a quarterly basis and would like for the meetings to be scheduled. These meetings will be held at 6:00 p.m.in each of the three council districts.

Council authorized the City Manager to arrange a 6:00 p.m. city council meeting to be held in District 1.

#### EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mayor Wukela stated that an Executive Session is required on a legal matter, a personnel matter and a contractual matter.

Councilman Willis made a motion to enter into Executive Session. Councilman Powers seconded the motion. There was no objection to the motion.

Council entered into Executive Session at 2:01 p.m.

Mayor Pro tem Brand left the meeting at 3:01 p.m.

Mayor Wukela reconvened the regular meeting at 3:17 p.m.

Mayor Wukela stated that a legal matter, a personnel matter and a contractual matter was discussed in Executive Session. The only matter that requires action is the renewal of the bonus for the City Manager on the same terms as last year.

Councilman Powers made a motion to renew the bonus for the City Manager on the same terms as last year. Councilman Willis seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

(Mayor Pro tem Brand and Councilwoman Williams-Blake were not present for the vote).



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AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-75 OF THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS OF THE CITY-COUNTY CIVIC CENTER COMMISSION, ONE APPOINTED BY THE FLORENCE CITY COUNCIL AND ONE APPOINTED BY THE FLORENCE COUNTY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the councils of both the City of Florence and the County of Florence are desirous of increasing the membership of the City-County Civic Center Commission by two new members, one to be appointed by the Florence City Council and one to be appointed by the Florence County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Florence County Council has passed Ordinance No. 25-2010/11making the change described above;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Florence that Section 2-75 of the City Code for Florence, South Carolina be, and the same is hereby, amended to read verbatim and provide as follows:

## Sec. 2-75. Florence City-County Civic Center Commission - Created, Membership, Terms

There is hereby created the Florence City-County Civic Center Commission, which shall consist of eleven (11) voting members and one ex officio, non-voting member. The voting members shall be as follows: Four (4) members shall be residents of the City of Florence, appointed by the Florence City Council, four (4) members shall be residents of Florence County, appointed by the Florence County Council. The Florence City Mayor and Florence County Council Chairman, or their council designee, with the approval of the respective council, shall also serve as voting members. After appointment, the commission shall recommend to the city and county councils the eleventh member to serve a four-year term. The ex officio, non-voting member shall be the civic center director. Effective July 1, 2011, the Commission membership shall be increased by two additional voting members to a total of 13 voting members; one appointee by the City of Florence and one appointee by Florence County, each to serve a four year term commencing on July 1, 2011, in accordance with this Section.

Terms of office for voting members appointed by the Florence City Council and the Florence County Council shall be for four (4) years and until successors are appointed and qualify, except those initially appointed, two (2) members appointed by the city council and two (2) members appointed by county council shall be appointed for two-year terms, and two (2) from each category shall be appointed for four-year terms. The terms of office for the Florence City Mayor and the Florence County Council Chairman shall be perpetual to the person holding that position. Vacancies on the commission shall be filled in the manner of original appointment for the unexpired term. After the eleventh member is appointed and approved by the city and county councils, the commission shall elect a chairman and secretary and such other officers as may be necessary. Members shall be eligible to serve on the commission for two (2) consecutive terms. The members of the commission shall not receive compensation for their services, but may be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred as members of the commission from any funds appropriated for that purpose.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption on second reading.






## Future Land Use









## **ZONING MAP**

#### I. ISSUE UNDER CONSIDERATION

a. The enactment of an ordinance banning the distribution, sale, and/or possession of a psychoactive substance known as Synthetic Marijuana

Synthetic Marijuana is defined as THC, HU-210 Cannabicyclohexanol, JWH-073 and refers to all chemical compounds intended to replicate, mimic, or cause a similar reaction to the effects of marijuana or cannabis. Such compounds are known as, or marketed under many names, included but not limited to names such as THC, HU-210, Cannabicyclohexanol, JWH-073, Potpourri, Spice, K-2, Blaze, herbal incense, herbal smoking blends, and other names.

b. The enactment of an ordinance banning the distribution, sale, and/or possession of a psychoactive substance known as Bath Salts

Bath Salts is defined as Methylenedioxypyrovalerone (MDPV), which is a psychoactive substance with stimulant properties which acts as a norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRI). It was reportedly sold as a legal drug alternative and marketed in the United States under many names, including but not limited to names such as Bath Salts, Fake Bath Salts, Cloud 9, Ivory Wave, Ocean, Charge Plus, White Lightening, Scarface, Hurricane Charlie, Vanilla Sky, Bonzai Grow, Blue Silk, Serenity Now, Lovely Dovey, Euphoria, Aura, Red Dove, Red X Dawn, White Dove, Plant Food, Fake Fertilize, Fake Insect Repellant, Magic, Super Coke, PV, and other names.

# II. CURRENT STATUS / PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN

None

#### III. POINTS TO CONSIDER

a. Synthetic marijuana has been developed in an effort to create and distribute a product which has similar hallucinogenic properties to natural marijuana, but cannot be prosecuted in South Carolina as a controlled substance. Studies around the nation have

indicated that synthetic marijuana usage is just as dangerous as is the usage of natural marijuana and carries with it additional dangers because of the unknown nature of any long-term effects of this synthetically created substance.

- b. Bath Salts is an alarming problem for the citizens of Florence because of the rapid increase in the number of people using the substance, and because of the serious harmful effects that it causes. Bath Salts is a very addictive substance that causes hallucinations, panic attacks, rapid heartbeat, agitation, aggression, fits, and delusions to name a few. It also causes serious health problems such as liver failure, kidney failure, and lung failure.
- c. At the present time, neither distributing, selling, nor possessing this substance can be prosecuted in South Carolina as a controlled substance, therefore every effort must be made to control this substance locally until a state or federal law can be enacted.
- d. Staff anticipates two witnesses from the Medical Profession to appear before council to provide information concerning the impact of Bath Salts.
- e. The ordinance requires two readings.

#### IV. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff stands ready to carry out the wishes of Council.

# ORDINANCE NO. 2011-

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION, POSSESSION, OR USE OF SYNTHETIC MARIJUANA AND BATH SALTS WITHIN THE CITY OF FLORENCE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Florence, upon assessing current conditions and more recent medical findings made by authoritative sources, has determined that neither the City's existing code nor the statutes of South Carolina sufficiently address the pressing public health issues arising from the life threatening harmful effects of the consumption or other use of newly developed drugs known as synthetic marijuana and as bath salts, and additional action by the City Council is necessary and proper; and

WHEREAS, The City Council (the "council") of the City of Florence, South Carolina, hereby finds and determines:

- (a) The City of Florence, South Carolina (the "City"), is an incorporated municipality located in Florence County, South Carolina, and as such possesses all powers granted to municipalities by the Constitution and the laws of the State of South Carolina, including the powers enumerated in S.C. Code § 5-7-30 (2005 Supp.) relating to regulating streets, markets, and public health.
- (b) A product known as Synthetic Marijuana has been developed in an apparent effort to create and distribute a product which has similar hallucinogenic qualities to natural marijuana but cannot currently be prosecuted in South Carolina as a controlled substance. It is now being possessed, distributed, and sold in the Florence area under several names including, but not limited to, Incense, Potpourri, Spice, K-2, and Blaze. Studies around the nation have indicated that Synthetic Marijuana usage carries with it all the dangers associated with usage of natural marijuana and carries with it additional dangers because of the unknown nature of any long term effects of this synthetically created substance.
- (c) Another manufactured product known as "Bath Salts", "Plant Food", "Fake Bath Salts", "Fake Fertilizer", and/or "Fake Insect Repellant" has been developed recently and is now being possessed, distributed, and sold in the Florence area under several names including, but not limited to, Cloud 9, Ivory Wave, Ocean, Charge Plus, White Lightening, Scarface, Hurricane Charlie, Vanella Sky, Bonzai Grow, Blue Silk, Serenity Now, Lovey Dovey, Euphoria, Aura, Red Dove, Red X Dawn, and White Dove. The usage of these compounds has affects very similar to the effects of Methamphetamine. Additionally, the usage of these compounds is causing serious and

life threatening health problems, including but not limited to, kidney failure, liver failure, and respiratory problems. Additional, studies have found the use of these compounds to be extremely addicting. Despite these dangers, these compounds have been manufactured in a way to avoid the existing state and federal laws regarding controlled substances. As a result, absent action by City Council, the sale, distribution, possession, and usage of these compounds would be lawful in the City of Florence.

- (d) Numerous studies have found that usage of synthetic marijuana and bath salts cause serious health problems including heart disease, liver failure, kidney disease, and respiratory disease. The 2011 edition of the U. S. Drug Enforcement Administration's "Drugs of Abuse: A DEA Resource Guide," designates bath salts as a drug of concern which poses risks to users despite not yet being listed as a controlled substance.
- (e) Many retail outlets in the City of Florence have voluntarily agreed to refuse to sell "bath salts" and "synthetic marijuana" under their many marketing names, but it is important and in the best interest of the citizens of Florence that the City be able to prohibit such sales until such time as the State of South Carolina or the federal government has the chance to regulate the use, sale, possession and distribution of said compounds.
- (f) The city recognizes that use of both synthetic marijuana and bath salts create a danger to the health and safety of the public at large, and, in order to protect the health and welfare of the public, it is necessary to prohibit the use, sale, possession and distribution of said compounds in the manner provided for in this article (the "article") as a stop gap measure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED, AND BY THE AUTHORITY THEREOF AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Enactment. The provisions contained in the attached Exhibit A shall be, and are hereby enacted by the City of Florence, and they shall be titled "Regulation of Synthetic Marijuana and Bath Salts" and contained in Chapter 10 of the City Code. The attached exhibit is fully incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Codification. The Municipal Code Corporation as codifier of the City of Florence Code shall, in consultation with the City Attorney of Florence, have discretion to make such adjustments in the numbering and sequencing of the article numbers and sections numbers as will reasonably assure compliance with standard practices in codification and to codify the new provisions as soon as feasible after their effective dates.

Section 3. Severability. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, it shall be construed to have been the legislative intent to pass said Ordinance without such invalid or unconstitutional provision, and the remainder of said Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid as if such portion had not been included. If said Ordinance, or any provisions thereof, is held to be inapplicable to any person, group of persons, property, kind of property, circumstances or set of circumstances, such as holding shall not affect the applicability thereof to any persons, property or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its approval and adoption on Second Reading.

### EXHIBIT A

# Regulation of Synthetic Marijuana and Bath Salts

# 10-60. Prohibition of Possession, Usage, Sale, and Distribution of Synthetic Marijuana and Bath Salts.

- (a) The advertisement, sale, distribution, possession, and/or usage of *synthetic marijuana* are hereby prohibited within the City of Florence.
- (b) The advertisement, sale, distribution, possession, and/or usage of Methylenedioxypyrovalerone (MDPV), which is commonly known as bath salts, are hereby prohibited within the City of Florence.

#### 10-61. Enforcement.

- (a) This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Police Department of Florence and by the office of the City Manager or an authorized designee.
- (b) Notice of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be given to all applicants for a business license in the City.
- (c) Any citizen who desires to register a complaint under this Ordinance may initiate enforcement with the Police Department of Florence or the office of the City Manager.

#### 10-62. Violations and Penalties.

- (a) A person or entity that violates the prohibitions contained in Section 10-60 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction, punishable by a civil fine in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
- (b) A person who owns, manages, operates, or otherwise controls a business location who fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction, punishable by a civil fine in the amount twenty-five dollars (\$25).
- (c) The possession, sale, distribution or use of each separate *package* of synthetic marijuana or bath salts shall constitute and be punished as a separate occurrence and infraction of this ordinance.
- (d) In order to enforce infractions of this ordinance, the city shall serve a uniform ordinance summons upon the infractor.

- (e) In addition to the civil fines established in this Section, three (3) or more violations of this ordinance by a person or entity that owns, manages, operates, or otherwise controls a place of business in the City of Florence shall be a reason for and may result in the suspension or revocation of any business license issued for the premises on which the infractions occurred.
- (f) In the event the infractor fails to pay the civil fine or fails to appear pursuant to uniform ordinance summons, the city may utilize the Set-Off Debt Process provided for under Section 12-56-50, et. seq. of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as Amended.
- (g) A violation of provisions of this ordinance by selling, marketing or distributing synthetic marijuana or bath salts shall constitute a nuisance in the City of Florence.

#### 10-63. Definitions.

Unless the context shall clearly indicate some other meaning, the terms defined in this section shall, for all purposes of this article and other documents herein referenced, have the meanings herein specified. Definitions shall be equally applicable to both the singular and plural forms of any of the terms herein defined.

- (a) Synthetic marijuana means THC, HU-210 Cannabicyclohexanol, JWH-073 and refers to all chemical compounds intended to replicate, mimic or cause a similar reaction to the effects of marijuana or cannabis. Such compounds are known as or marketed under many names, including but not limited to, such names as THC, HU-210 Cannabicyclohexanol, JWH-073, Potpourri, Spice, K-2, Blaze, herbal incense, herbal smoking blends, and other names.
- (b) Bath salts mean Methylenedioxypyrovalerone (MDPV), which is a psychoactive drug with stimulant properties which acts as a norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRI). It is also known as MDPK, Magic, Super Coke and PV. It was reportedly sold as a legal drug alternative and marketed in the United States as "bath salts", "Plant Food", "Fake Bath Salts", "Fake Fertilizer", and/or "Fake Insect Repellant" under many marketing names, including but not limited to such names as Cloud 9, Ivory Wave, Ocean, Charge Plus, White Lightening, Scarface, Hurricane Charlie, Vanella Sky, Bonzai Grow, Blue Silk, Serenity Now, Lovey Dovey, Euphoria, Aura, Red Dove, Red X Dawn and White Dove.
- (c) Package means each single unit marketing package or packaging for synthetic marijuana and/or bath salts.

This Ordinance follows the "Anderson Model" discussed at the meeting on August 11. The ordinance has been designed to accomplish the following specific goals:

- 1. Establish the mechanism needed for Council to consider and approve applications for incentives on a case-by-case basis;
- 2. Establish the minimum requirements that must be met before Council will approve an application for incentive;
- 3. Establish a set of criteria that Council will consider on a case-by-case basis in determining whether to approve an incentive for a project that meets the minimum pre-requisites, and the amount of any such incentive.
- 4. Establish the administrative criteria and the terms of delivery of incentives granted.

# II. CURRENT STATUS/PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

At the last council meeting, after receiving a briefing and legal advice, Council requested that staff develop an incentive package ordinance for the September Council Meeting following the outline provided by staff and the city attorney.

# III. POINTS TO CONSIDER

- 1. It is important to note that the Ordinance and the resulting Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program specifically do not address the anticipated low interest loan pool and facade grant program that Mr. Reich has described. These programs will be designed to assist smaller projects than those addressed in this package and will not be limited by the criteria and requirements discussed in this Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program.
- 2. Assuming that Council passes the ordinance attached, or something close to it, then, using the program established by the ordinance, applications for incentives will come

before Council on a case-by-case basis and Council, after applying the requirements and criteria set out in the ordinance, will address the application for incentive by resolution.

# ORDINANCE NO. 2011-

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING NEW CODE SECTIONS 2-200 THROUGH 2-207 IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DOWNTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF FLORENCE

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Florence, South Carolina recognizes that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Florence to encourage the economic development and redevelopment of the downtown area of the City and to provide for the increased benefit and prosperity of its citizens;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to facilitate business growth in designated areas;

WHEREAS, the Council may from time to time identify designated areas that correspond with the City's adopted master plans and/or redevelopment plans, with such plans identifying the need for both public and private investment to ensure success;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to create new tools to encourage private capital investment and reinvestment in any of the designated areas that may be specifically identified;

WHEREAS, the establishment of an economic development program that recognizes the benefits and economic impact of new investment will contribute to the health and stability of the City and in furtherance of the various adopted goals and plans of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Florence, South Carolina, hereby finds and determines:

- (a) The City of Florence, South Carolina (the "City"), is an incorporated municipality located in Florence County, South Carolina, and as such possesses all powers granted to municipalities by the Constitution and the laws of the State of South Carolina, including the powers enumerated in S.C. Code § 5-7-30.
- (b) Council is mindful of the criteria set forth by the South Carolina Supreme Court in Byrd v. Florence County in determining when industrial development constitutes a public purpose. In that case, as further developed in Nichols v. South Carolina Research Authority, the South Carolina Supreme Court formulated a four-point standard to include (1) the ultimate goal or benefit to the public, (2) whether public or private parties will be the primary beneficiaries, (3) the speculative nature of the project and (4) the probability that the public interest will be ultimately served.

- (c) While recognizing that the provision of incentives to private developers has some benefit to the private developers, the purpose of this incentive program is to benefit the citizens of the City by encouraging revitalization and redevelopment of the downtown area thereby bringing about great positive direct economic impact upon the City, indirect economic impact upon the City by attracting additional businesses, investment and patronage into the downtown, and through enhancing quality of life and enjoyment issues by restoring the historic downtown area of Florence. Council has therefore applied the four-part test formulated by the Supreme Court to the incentive program to ensure that Council's decision on individual incentive applications will be based upon consideration of proper objective criteria.
- (d) The criteria and requirements under the incentive program are designed to make sure that decisions by Council will properly weigh the benefit to the public and the established goals of the City for effective redevelopment of the downtown area and to ensure that the benefit to the public greatly outweighs any private benefit resulting from any incentive granted.
- (e) As repeatedly stated in both the City's Comprehensive Plan and the Master Plan for downtown revitalization, the provision of significant incentives to encourage investment in downtown properties is essential for the success of these programs.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED, AND BY THE AUTHORITY THEREOF AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Enactment. The provisions contained in the attached Exhibit A shall be, and are hereby enacted by the City of Florence, and they shall be titled "Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program" and contained in Chapter 2 of the City Code. The attached exhibit is fully incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. Codification. The Municipal Code Corporation as codifier of the City of Florence Code shall, in consultation with the City Attorney of Florence, have discretion to make such adjustments in the numbering and sequencing of the article numbers and sections numbers as will reasonably assure compliance with standard practices in codification and to codify the new provisions as soon as feasible after their effective dates.
- Section 3. Severability. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, it shall be construed to have been the legislative intent to pass said Ordinance without such invalid or unconstitutional provision, and the remainder of said Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid as if such portion had not been included. If said Ordinance, or any provisions thereof, is held to be inapplicable to any person, group of persons, property, kind of property, circumstances or set of circumstances, such as holding shall not affect the applicability thereof to any persons, property or circumstances.

# ARTICLE IV - DOWNTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Sec. 2-200. - Title.

Sec. 2-200. - Title.

This ordinance shall be titled the "Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program".

Sec. 2-201. - Authority.

The Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program is enacted pursuant to the powers conferred upon the municipality.

# Sec. 2-202. - Purpose.

The purpose of the Downtown Economic Development Incentive Program is to allow public support of economic projects to foster, promote, and enhance economic development efforts in areas in which development is challenged by blight, history, and changes in growth patterns over the years. The purpose of the article is to allow and establish criteria for the City of Florence to enter into an agreement with a person, firm or corporation who/that undertake/s a development project consistent with the city's adopted master plan for the downtown area and/or redevelopment plans and the provisions herein and to provide the criteria to be considered by City Council in its analysis of projects seeking incentives.

#### Sec. 2-203. - Definitions.

The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Capital investment. Capital investment is defined as an activity that adds value to the city's tax base by the acquisition and/or improvement of real property.

Development. Development is defined as the activity of improving a real property to the extent of adding value to the tax base through real property improvements, and the creation and/or retention of employment opportunities.

Cumulative capital investment. Cumulative capital investment is defined as meeting the capital investment in the development of multiple real properties during a maximum period of three years.

Tax increment finance district (TIF). The TIF is defined as the downtown tax increment finance district. The geographical boundaries of the applicable area shall remain after expiration of the TIF.

Incentive. Incentive shall be defined as a grant of any inducement having monetary value by the City of Florence that is offered to a person, firm, or corporation to pursue a development that encourages private investment and/or the creation/retention of jobs. The incentive may also include grants from other public entities that the City of Florence may be able to obtain.

Real property value. Real property value is defined according to the value assigned by the Florence County Tax Assessor's Office.

Incremental increase. Incremental increase is the difference in the real property value at the beginning of the incentive period and the real property value upon completion of the first taxable year of occupancy of the new development.

#### Sec. 2-204. – Applicability.

The city council may, at its discretion and on a case-by-case basis, and according to available funding, enter into an agreement with a person, firm or corporation for the purpose of providing an economic development incentive.

The provision of incentive/s shall be made only after an agreement has been entered into between the person, firm, or corporation setting forth the particulars of the development and the incentives. Such agreement shall be executed upon approval by resolution of the city council.

#### Sec. 2-205. - General eligibility criteria.

The following criteria shall be considered in the analysis of the eligibility of any proposed project for incentives hereunder and in determining the size and type of incentives to be approved:

- a) The proposed project must be consistent with an adopted City of Florence Master Plan and/or Redevelopment Plan.
- b) The proposed project must be located within the Historic Overlay District, within the TIF District as specifically identified and designated by the city council, or within the CDBG Area of the City of Florence.

- c) The proposed project must have a minimum threshold investment which may be comprised of a combination of physical improvements and acquisition costs, and such threshold investment may be comprised of a single real property investment or a cumulative investment. The amount of any incentive approved shall take into account the size of the *cumulative capital investment* involved in the proposed project, the anticipated economic impact of the project, and the anticipated revenue impact on the City of Florence.
- d) The proposed project must be for one or more of the following:
  - 1. Retail uses as identified in Zoning Ordinance of the City of Florence;
  - 2. Tourism and hospitality-related business or activity;
  - 3. Cultural arts activities and associated businesses:
  - 4. Corporate headquarters and financial institutions;
  - 5. Research and development;
  - 6. High technology growth business;
  - 7. Residential uses as designated in the specific eligibility criteria in Sec. 2-206 below;
  - 8. Other uses as may be determined by the City of Florence which carry out the intent of this ordinance and as are identified more specifically according to the adopted master plans and/or redevelopment plans applicable in the respective areas.

#### Sec. 2-206. – Specific eligibility criteria.

Within the designated areas identified below, in addition to the general criteria set out in Section 2-205, City Council shall consider the specific requirements and criteria enumerated in the chart below which are designed to address the needs of the specific geographic areas and the respective master plan and/or redevelopment plan pertaining to the designated areas.

- (f) The anticipated positive impact on surrounding properties and the area in general.
- (g) The anticipated retention of or creation of jobs involved in the proposed project provided and the pay level of such jobs.
- (h) Whether residential development proposals are in compliance with the Master Plan adopted by the City and create market rate housing.

# TIF District - Outside Historic District designated above

- (a) Threshold investment as described in Sec. 2-205(c) of at least \$1,000,000.00.
- (b) The project shall be for commercial development or for residential development involving multiple residential units.
- (c) The extent to which the proposed project furthers the goals for the redevelopment of the downtown area as established in the Master Plan and in the Ordinances establishing and governing the overlay district in which the project is located.
- (c) The extent to which the proposed project positively impacts the *real property value* of the parcels involved and results in an *incremental increase* in the district, and results in increased revenues for the City.
- (d) The risk being assumed by the developer to undertake the proposed project given the status of the redevelopment efforts in the district.
- (e) The anticipated positive impact on surrounding parcels.
- (f) The anticipated retention of or creation of jobs

	(e) The risk being assumed by the developer to undertake the proposed project given the status of the redevelopment efforts in the district.

	(g) The anticipated retention of or creation of jobs involved in the proposed project and the pay level of such jobs.

# Sec. 2-207. – Administrative criteria and terms of delivery.

- a) The person, firm, or corporation must apply for the economic development incentive program, provide sufficient documentation on the development, provide a letter of credit or other evidence satisfactory to the City showing financial viability of the proposed project, and agree to furnish good faith estimates on projected sales tax, assessed valuation, and other information as may be needed to determine the incentives that may be provided and the amount of the incentive.
- b) The incentive amount shall be determined based upon the amount of the capital investment and new revenue generated as a result of the capital investment as calculated over a period not to exceed twenty years. The incentive term shall

commence with the issuance of the certificate of occupancy, issuance of a business license, and/or other criteria corresponding to the eligibility factors. The incentive shall require annual monitoring by the City of Florence to ensure continued program compliance; monitoring during the incentive period shall include benchmarks such as, but not limited to, the completion of the first taxable year of occupancy and first year of operation of the identified business use; benchmarks shall be monitored for each year of the incentive period.

- c) The total incentive amount shall not be greater than the value received by the city and derived from the capital investment during the term of the incentive.
- d) The City of Florence may, in its discretion, extend the incentive time period if deemed warranted based upon the continuing benefit created by the investment.
- e) The City of Florence may increase or decrease the amount of the incentive based upon actual development and real property values as determined through the monitoring process.
- f) If at any time during the incentive period the development's use does not meet the eligibility criteria, then the city may deem the agreement null and void.
- g) If at any time during the incentive period the development is sold, the benefits of the incentive may be assigned to the new owner only upon written consent of the city. Consent by the City will not be withheld unreasonably.
- h) If at any time during the incentive period the real property value is appealed, then the incentive amount may be renegotiated or voided.
- i) The administration of this program shall be the responsibility of the Downtown Development Office.







## Overview

## **Touching Lives—Transforming Communities**

Touching Lives project is a community model to help qualified participants develop living skills, spiritual growth, and educational achievement for themselves and their families

- Each designated Touching Lives home will be a living laboratory of transformation.
- 2. Each qualified family will require them to develop a life plan and goals that will lead them out of poverty/homelessness into self-sufficiency.
- 3. Touching Lives will surround each family with a support team from the faith community. These teams will help them navigate needed services such as counseling, training, and other community support.
- 4. Participating families will be held responsible for adhering to the terms of the programs agreement and behavioral contract.

### The Process

- Each participant will complete a personal assessment to determine personal goals and areas of strengths and weakness.
- Individualized development plans will be developed to target training, education and service needs.
- Participant's stay in Touching Lives housing will be based on the completion of their contractual goals.
- Participant's rent will be based on income. Rent will increase as income increases. In most cases, participants will be required to pay utilities.
- Each resident will be asked to become an active member of a local sponsoring church and participate in community volunteer services.

The program will coordinate the resources of area churches, local agencies, organizations and existing services to meet the needs of participants.

The program will provide or refer residents to support services including:

Health care Individual/family counseling

Parenting skills Basic living skills

Chemical dependency intervention Day care

Career counseling Vocational training and placement

Business development GED certification
Tutoring services Crisis intervention
Health and exercise facilities Spiritual education

Homework center Financial planning and debt reduction

Transportation Adult education
