## **STAFF REPORTS:**

#### Tim:

We had a great summer basketball league. Registration for football, soccer, and cheerleading has ended. We are getting ready for fall basketball, fall softball, and fall volleyball. Ultimate frisbee will possibly be added this year.

The new playground at Northwest should be completed by Friday, August 6th. The other parks will hopefully be completed by September. There is no date on the parking lot project at Northwest at this time. The Southpark fencing project was bid out, paving was signed, and the bathrooms at Maple Park and McLeod Park are almost complete.

## Jerry:

The ten-year comp plan is to be rewritten. There is a strong emphasis on recreation and outdoor activities. Youth recreation, trail connectivity, sports, recreation, and trails were all ranked high from the community. Thirty-six to thirty-eight acres were added to the site. We currently have 4 miles out of the 10-mile goal for the mountain bike trail.

#### Chuck:

We plan to continue working on the landscape in the next 3 months at the Lawton-Chase House. The humane society is requesting the use of the house to host an event to recognize their sponsors.

The sports complex is moving along, an outline for completion is being defined now. Additional funds have been spent on unsuitable soil repairs. Unsuitable soil was found on the track. The expected cost is somewhere between \$250,000 and \$350,000. American rescue funds to the City totaled \$7,000,000. The city manager feels \$680,000 to finish the youth baseball fields at the new sports complex.

Chuck will be retiring from the City this afternoon for 30 days and then plans to return.
