FLORENCE, SC – The South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board (SCORF Board) was created by the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Act, to administer and distribute funding in accordance with the terms of settlement agreements resulting from the *In re South Carolina Opioid Litigation*.

The City of Florence serves as a participating political subdivision for the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Funding to authorize funding requests.
