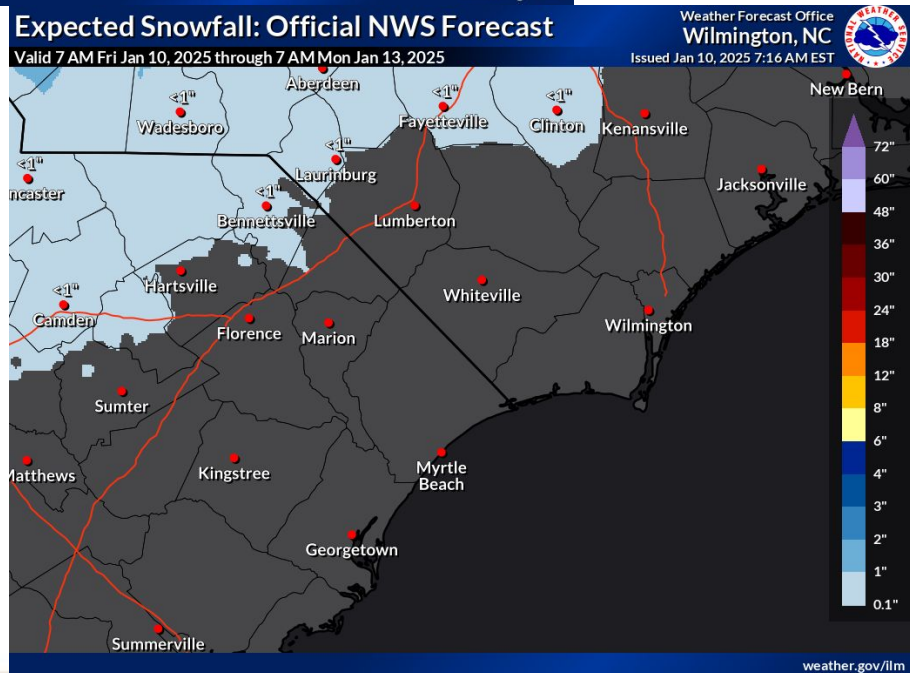
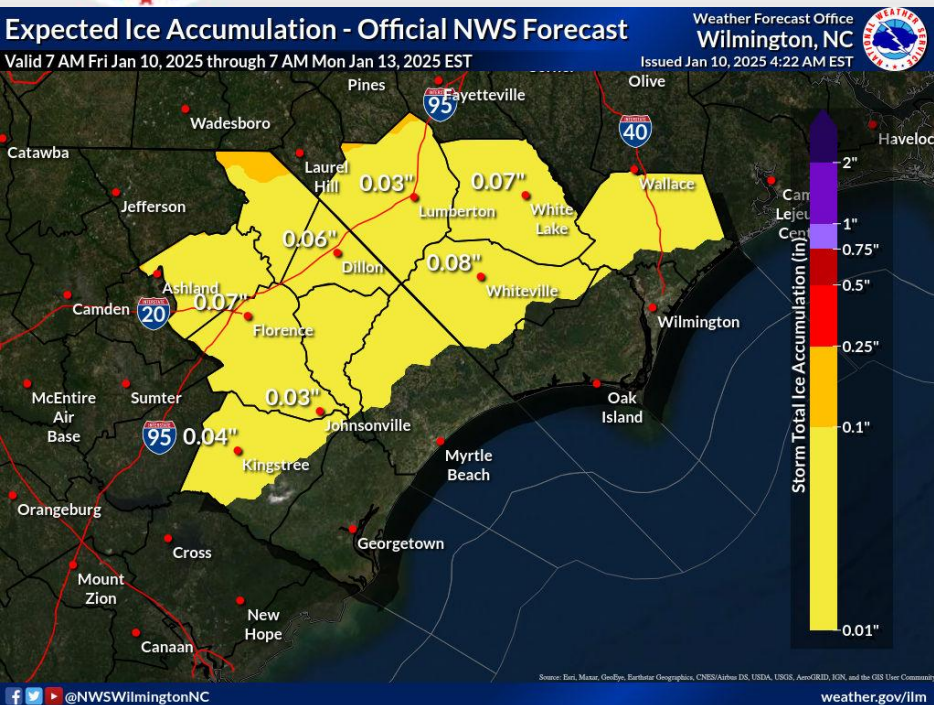




Winter Weather Update

OVERVIEW

Low pressure moving up the Southeast U.S. coast Friday night will lead to light freezing rain over inland areas. Dry and chilly then for later Saturday into Sunday.

TIMING

From late Friday afternoon through Friday night. Temperatures may stay around freezing for much of the night far inland, while towards the coast they should rise above freezing through the night.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- *Ice:* As shown in the image on the upper left, up to around 0.10 inch of freezing rain is expected away from the coast, where a **Winter Weather Advisory** is in effect. Higher amounts up to 0.20 inch are possible over far NW areas, but not enough to warrant an Ice Storm Warning (0.25 inch) at this time.
- *Other Winter Weather:* Some sleet and snow will mix in with the freezing rain especially at the onset, but as shown in the image on the lower left, any accumulations will be light (under an inch).
- Freezing rain will create treacherous driving conditions, especially across bridges, overpasses, and other elevated road surfaces.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- *Confidence:* Moderate to High confidence that at least light ice accumulations will occur inland.
